Pregnancy Support Progress – over 50 people registered or attended the Zoom session on 5th September. We're narrowing down the options to a short list and I hope to be able to let you know the next steps soon

"STOP Abortion Aid" The Archdiocese has called on Catholics to write to their MPs to stop aid money being spent on abortion. In the first three months of the pandemic (March – May 2020) over £8 million was given to one abortion provider, Marie Stopes. The same figures show nothing being given to UK Catholic aid charities such as SCIAF or Mary's Meals. This was picked up by [The Universe newspaper](#) and is also on the [Archdiocesan website](#)
