DIY Home Abortion: Write to your MSPs

A new opinion poll confirms an <u>overwhelming majority of the Scottish public have expressed</u> <u>concerns</u> about the Government's "barbaric" DIY home abortions. The opinion poll found **more than 8 in 10 Scottish adults** were concerned that DIY abortion increases the risk of domestic abuse as well as the chance of pills being falsely obtained for someone else. Vaccines

The Vatican has issued a <u>Note on the morality of using some anti-Covid-19 vaccines</u> It says you can take the vaccine in good conscience because the link to abortion is remote. However the Note also says you have no obligation to use the vaccine & participation is voluntary.

Background: In the UK the Government has bought 7 vaccines from <u>Oxford University/AstraZeneca</u>, <u>Pfizer</u>, <u>Moderna</u>, GSK/Sanofi, Janssen, Novavax & Valneva. The first 3 (in <u>bold</u>) have been approved for use. The Oxford/AstraZeneca vaccine used aborted fetal cells at every stage. The Pfizer and Moderna vaccines did not use fetal cells in design/development or production but did use them in some confirmatory testing. The pro-life <u>Lozier Institute</u> has the best information on all the vaccines.
