# Westminster – 'strict' safeguards???

The Terminally III Adults (End of Life) Bill continues its scrutiny at Westminster where the Committee put together by sponsor, Kim Leadbeater has been very controversial. As many as 80+ reasonable and sensible amendments have been voted down by the committee including:

- A prohibition on "encouraging" someone to choose assisted suicide;
- A requirement to have a meeting with a palliative care consultant;
- A requirement that capacity must include understanding key details; and
- A refusal to eat and drink not to be considered a 'terminal illness'
