

St Columba's and St Peter's, Edinburgh 19th Sunday of the Year — Year C 10—24 August 2025 (This newsletter covers 2 weeks)



The emphasis here is on readiness for the return of the Lord. Even though the disciples are only a `little flock' in a hostile world, they must not be discouraged, but must look with confidence to the Father who has chosen them for His Kingdom. The longer form of the gospel contains 3 parables. (1) the parable of the bridesmaids waiting for the bridegroom, Jesus, to return from the wedding feast. (2) The parable of the householder waiting for the thief who comes in the □ night. (3) The parable of the servants waiting for their master to return. Essentially, they make the same point. They all relate to the coming of the Son of Man. Since the disciples do not know the exact hour of his return, they must maintain a constant watchfulness and faithfulness. Though these words have relevance for all Christians, Luke was thinking especially of leaders in



u the community, and calling them to a selfless service of their Lord and of their fellow Christians. Flor McCarthy SDB
